Meeting called to order by President Mike Joyal at 11:32am.

Minutes of the 03/21/14 meeting were unanimously approved.

Jeanne Beaudin provided a year to date financial report through 4/18/14. Receipts to date are \$14,816.06, expenditures of \$3,918.33 and the checkbook balance of \$44,634.56. The budget report was unanimously approved. There was a brief discussion of the membership dues for associate members with no action. There are currently 101 full members and 34 associate members.
