Regional Director John McGough provides executive leadership as the primary representative for the Secretary of Health & Human Services for 6 New England states of Connecticut, Maine, Massachusetts, New Hampshire, Rhode Island, and Vermont, as well as the Region's 10 federally recognized Tribes.

Combatting the opioid epidemic is a top priority for HHS. Regional Director McGough will outline the Administration's 5-point opioid strategy as well as our progress in New England, and New Hampshire specifically.

Additionally, the Regional Director will provide an overview of the Whole Family Approach to Jobs initiative which aims to address multi-generational poverty. The initiative is a regional collaborative effort committed to resolving the welfare benefits cliff effect.

9:00 a.m. Marijuana Legalization and What it Means for Municipalities

Presented by Malina E. Dumas, Attorney, DrummondWoodsum and Edward (Ted) J. Kelleher, Attorney, DrummondWoodsum
