Topic

New Hampshire Lottery is reaching out to inform municipalities about the Keno component of SB 191, the Kindergarten bill. Keno must be approved in each town in order for the game to be offered in establishments with valid pouring licenses, such as taverns and restaurants; and that vote must take place during the annual town meeting. During municipal city elections this past November, residents in six cities across New Hampshire approved the sale of KENO 603. KENO 603 is on sale now in more than 40 bars and restaurants and the New Hampshire Lottery is adding new sales locations weekly. The game, which is administered by the New Hampshire Lottery, is on sale daily from 11 AM to 11 PM with drawings every five minutes. As with any lottery game, only those 18 or older are allowed to play.

Charlie McIntyre has worked for the NH Lottery since 2010 and was formerly the Assistant Executive Director and General Counsel for the Massachusetts State Lottery. He possesses extensive experience in gaming best practices and gambling regulation as well as law enforcement. Before joining the Massachusetts Lottery in 2003, McIntyre was a senior prosecutor with the Norfolk District Attorney's office, specializing in drug enforcement, organized crime, and gambling.
