I am writing on behalf of the Municipal Management Association of New Hampshire (MMANH) to invite you to renew your membership or join our state managers' organization for the 2018 membership year. The MMANH provides the only statewide opportunity for local government managers to network and access educational programs tailored specifically for our professional and regional interests.

At only \$100 per year, the value and direct benefits of full membership include reduced rates for MMANH's annual conference, access to our e-mail list serve for real-time discussion and immediate advice from professional colleagues from around the state, and regular meetings for gathering and discussing current topics with subject area experts. With a reduced rate of \$50 annually, associate members who may not meet the requirements of full membership, receive member benefits including participating in the annual conference, sub-committees and regular meetings.
